

APIARY LOCATION(S)

As required by **The Vermont Statutes, Title 6, Chapter 172**, it is the duty of every person having *one or more colonies of bees* in their possession or under their control to *report the location* of such colonies. It is essential that apiary inspectors know the locations of all colonies of bees in Vermont in order to effectively control honey bee diseases and pests. Please provide location information for each apiary or bee yard in the space below. A sketch or verbal description indicating the location from major roads or landmarks, with distances, would be helpful. For instance, “Bob Beekeeper residence, 123 Honey Lane, 0.3 miles off RT 75, just north of Honeytown, 4th house on the left.” The more information provided the better!! Attach additional sheets if needed.
