Some units, such as "bunch" are variable, making the price range larger than it would be for a more standardized unit. Organic prices are for goods defined as organic by the producer and are not limited to certified organic produce.

The price report is off to a weak start for the year. Get your pencils out and send in those price reports! If the weather cooperates as the season goes on, I'm sure we'll have more to report.
