We also received prices for the following, but not enough to report: raspberries, strawberries, watermelon, dried be cantaloupe, cauliflower, kale, looseleaf lettuce, pumpkins, rhubarb, hubbard squash, turnips and chives. Also artichokes and delicata squash.

Last week there was no price summary because we did not receive enough reports to generate one.

We did not report a price if only one was received. No average is reported when there are only two prices reported for the same crop and the same units. some units, such as "bunch" are variable, making the price range larger than would be for a more standardized unit. Organic prices are for goods defined as organic by the producer and are not limited to certified organic produce.
