Black Currants, Black Raspberries, Carrots w/Tops, Catnip, Cauliflower, Dried Beans, Gooseberries, Green Beans, Green Cabbage, Green Peppers, Kale, Mesclun, Onions, Oregano, Popcorn, Red Currants, Sweet Corn, Turnips & Wax Beans.

We did not report a price if only one was received. No average is reported when there are only two prices reported for the same crop and the same units. Some units, such as "bunch" are variable, making the price range larger than it would be for a more standardized unit. Organic prices are for goods defined as organic by the producer and are not limited to certified organic produce. This week, we received 16 reports.
