**REQUIREMENT OF THE VERMONT DEPARTMENT OF TAXES**

By law (32 V.S.A. Section 3113) no agency of the State may renew a license or other authority to conduct a trade of business (including a license to practice a profession) unless the licensee first certifies, under the pains and penalties of perjury, that he or she is in good standing with the Department of Taxes. A person is in good standing if no taxes are due, if the liability for any tax that may be due is on appeal, if the taxpayer is in compliance with a payment plan approved by the Commissioner of Taxes, or if the licensing authority determines that immediate payment of taxes due and payable would pose unreasonable hardship.

The maximum penalty for perjury is fifteen (15) years in prison, a \$10,000 fine or both.
