MILKING AND PROCESSING EQUIPMENT INSTALATION AND REPAIR REGISTRATION

Vermont Statutes, Title 6, Section 2724(b) designates that by December 31 of every third year all companies doing installations or repairs to milking equipment and dairy processing equipment must register with the Secretary of Agriculture. The registration is good for three years. Applications for renewals must be completed and returned prior to December 1. New applications are accepted any time however licenses will always expire on December 31 on the third year of the license. (see attached statute)

Tax Department Requirement

By signing This Application You Certify That You Are In Good Standing with the Requirements Below.

By law (15 V.S.A. Section 795), the State may not renew a license for trade or business unless the licensee first certifies that he or she is in good standing with any order to pay child support.

By law (32 V.S.A. Sec. 3113), the State may not renew a license for business or trade unless the licensee certifies, under the pains and penalties of perjury, that he/she is in good standing with the Department of Taxes. The maximum penalties for perjury are fifteen (15) years in prison, a \$10,000 fine or both.

- Good standing means:
- that no taxes are due;
 - the liability is on appeal;
 - the licensee is complying with a State authorized payment plan; or
 - the immediate payment would cause unreasonable hardship. (If you are claiming hardship, please contact the licensing agency for further information.)

VSA TITLE 6, CHAPTER 151, SECTION 2724(B) - (b) Any commercial enterprise which installs or repairs milking or dairy processing equipment shall register with the secretary. The company shall apply for registration on a form made available by the agency. The registration shall be valid for three years. Before registering a company, the secretary shall determine that the company is qualified to perform the installation or repair service. The registration form shall be accompanied by a fee of \$100.00. The secretary may suspend or revoke registration for cause after giving the installer the opportunity to be heard. Registration shall terminate on December 31 of each year. Electricians or plumbers licensed pursuant to Title 26 doing only electrical or plumbing work within a farm or plant shall be exempt from this registration provided any work directly related to the processing of dairy products or milking of animals is performed under the supervision of a person that is registered. Any company that fails to renew by December 31 shall pay a \$25.00 late fee, and the registration shall lapse if it is more than 30 days late.
