02


BMPs

Internally working on revisions. Stakeholder input will be the next process but could be Fall 2022.










Figure 1. Pathways for microplastics entry into the environment via organic soil amendments

Vermont Pay for Performance Program

- $\circ~\$7M\,USDA\,NRCS\,RCPP\,Grant\,to\,AAFM$
- Goal is to reduce phosphorus above and beyond the 40% required in the TMDL for Lake Champlain.
- Available Statewide (extrapolated Lake Champlain data methods)

- Data Entry Payments is a one-time payment of \$15/ac up to \$4000/ farm
- Phosphorus Payments are **annual** up to \$100/lb of phosphorus up to
 \$50,000/farm






Farm Example
