<i>Dermacentor albipictus</i>	Winter Tick	Deer and moose	Various wildlife pathogens
<i>Dermacentor variabilis</i>	American dog tick	Dog, other wild and domestic mammals	Rocky Mountain spotted fever, tularemia
<i>Haemaphysalis chordeilis</i>	Bird Tick	Birds, sometimes poultry	Various wildlife pathogens
<i>Haemaphysalis leporispalustris</i>	Rabbit Tick	Rabbits, ground birds, sometimes domestic animals	Rocky Mountain spotted fever, tularemia
<i>Ixodes angustus</i>	Rodent tick	Rodents	
<i>Ixodes brunneus</i>	None	Birds	
<i>Ixodes cookei</i>	Woodchuck Tick	Woodchucks, other wild and domestic mammals	Powassan virus
<i>Ixodes dentatus</i>	Rabbit Tick	Rabbits	
<i>Ixodes gregsoni</i>	Fisher Tick	Fishers	
<i>Ixodes marxi</i>	Squirrel Tick	Squirrels	Powassan virus
<i>Ixodes muris</i>	Mouse Tick	Small rodents	
<i>Ixodes scapularis</i>	Blacklegged Tick, Deer Tick	Deer, other wild and domestic mammals	Lyme disease, anaplasmosis, babesiosis, and Powassan virus
